General Information

Only the children or grandchildren of deceased, disabled, or other veterans and serving members will be considered and preference will definitely be given to Branch #172 members.

The availability of all Bursaries will depend on the availability of the Branch funds.

Bursaries will be awarded to students wishing to enter University, a Regional College, or an approved Vocational or Technical training school in the Province of British Columbia.

An award might be granted for those entering second, third, and fourth year University, depending on availability of funds.

It should be noted that all items are to be sent or delivered together before an interview can be arranged.

It should also be noted that an award offered to an applicant must be accepted within 14 days following notification of the award. If a reply has not been received within that time, the award will be offered to another worthy applicant.

All awards will be for the next term at the institution of the Applicant's stated request and the awards will be payable to that Institution.

2. A letter of reference from the School Principal or Counsellor. The letter is to cover your ability, physical fitness, character and industry.
3. A written statement setting out your aims and objects must be submitted. The statement is to be neatly written, concise and state only expected degree or profession.

Students entering University must provide:

1. A fully completed application form.
2. A written statement setting out your aims and objects. The letter is to be neatly written and state only expected degree or profession.
